

Aren and Matthias put the lighting and bunting up outside. The pole is long and heavy. Matthias has to push it very hard and hold it steady while Aren puts it on the base. It is a tricky job. They have done it lots of times so make it look easy.



We have to make the circus area safe for the public. Ash digs a small trench for the electric cable and then covers it up so people don't trip on it.



Everything is set up inside the Big Top ready for the show. Aren unties the ropes so that the sides of the tent come down.



We have lunch before we get ready for the show. We always come together at meal times.

Our boss, Damian, reminds us of the jobs that we still need to do today.



After lunch we take turns to clear the meal and wash the dishes. Today it is Aren, Anna and Ash's turn.



We call the kitchen caravan the chuckwagon. We take turns cooking the meals and, because I made lunch, I also clean up the chuckwagon.

Anna makes the popcorn in the popcorn machine. It smells delicious.



Matthias takes the props he needs for his performance into the Big Top. I wonder what is in the old suitcase?

There is a lot to do. We work as fast as we can so that we get it all packed up before it gets dark.

We have packed up and left everything neat and tidy. Children ride bikes and dogs walk where our tents used to be. See you next year!
